

GLADE CAMP

Site Information

The Glade Camp is a woodland clearing which can accommodate one group of up to 50 with their own camping equipment, situated to the east of the Centre Office and adjacent to Hornbeam House (it is also suitable for use with Hornbeam, a high-standard accommodation building with 34 beds). It is ideal for those groups who want to camp in a woodland setting with water supply, flush toilets and electricity hook-up on site and also have access to good recreational facilities. There is vehicular access to Glade Camp for loading/unloading – car parking spaces are provided nearby.

Charges for the Glade include use of the woods, sports field, all-weather sports field, low-ropes course and occasional use of the sports hall. Use of the indoor swimming pool, instructed activities (pedal-karting, climbing, abseiling, archery, kayaking, open canoeing, raft-building, team development tasks and others) are provided at an additional cost – these are subject to availability and should be booked as far in advance as possible. If you haven't already booked these please call us to arrange this on 01732 361361.

A payphone is not available – but urgent telephone calls may be made from the Centre Office (during normal working hours where possible). The Rock Shop (centre tuck shop) is kept well stocked and may be used under a leader's supervision. Please ask for a key on arrival. Conditions for the use of the low ropes course, indoor swimming pool and general centre rules are given in a separate leaflet. You will require qualified first aiders in order to use the low-ropes course and swimming pool.

Games equipment, mallet(s)

Please ensure that the logs seats around the camp fire are not burnt. Please clean out the Barbeque after use, remove all left-over food and dispose of your rubbish in the bin area. When you leave, all equipment provided by Rock UK should be returned in a clean and undamaged condition.
